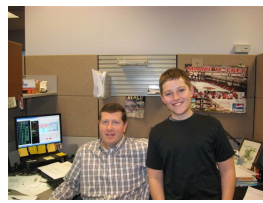

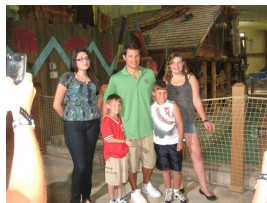

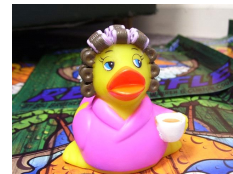

4th Annual Rubber Duckie Regaffle



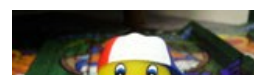
2011 Souvenir Ducks
